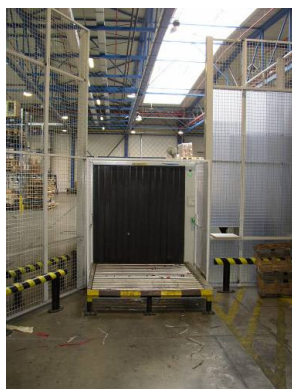

New Regulation EC No 831/2006



On January 1st, 2008 a new Regulation EC number 831/2006 entered into validity which changed procedure of handling of shipments which due to their size can't be X-rayed. The main change is the length of quarantine which was changed from 48 hours to 5 days. In order to minimize the impact of the change on the handling procedure the two new alternatives for checking of dangerous and forbidden goods were introduced. We mean physical checking and physical checking with the explosive-detector. This service was introduced for you at Prague Airport. We would kindly ask you to inform us in advance and agree the procedure if the case occurs. The simplest solution is still to adjust the size of your shipment to meet requirements for X-ray checking, i.e. 120x80x160 cm.

A newly established position of Cargo Dispatcher



We would like to inform you that on March 1st, 2008 a new position of Cargo Dispatcher was introduced in Skyport a.s.. Main responsibility is to coordinate and optimize the activities on air-side. In practice the dispatcher controls distribution and delivery of cargo and mail and ensures direct contact with airline carriers, arranges re-booking for next flights, supervises scheduled terms in which cargo has to be brought and transported and in case of damage

or loss he settles all these cases and other discrepancies. Nowadays two our employees provide these services on workdays from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m. so they cover rush hour. If we consider this service useful also at night hours we will think of extending this service as a non-stop service.

Parallel training of our employees

We have the pleasure to announce that 21 of our employees have successfully passed the IT course which was organized by the AUTOCONT company. Our aim is to keep on increasing the qualification of our employees and improving our customer services.
